PRIME TIME, JULY 3

Our special guest for our July Prime Time will be retired Air Force Colonel Warren Ward. Col. Ward's resume is so extensive that we can only list a little of it here. He currently is the Chief of the Plans, Programs and Requirements Division of the Air Force Nuclear Command, Control and Communications Center, Air Force Global Strike Command at Barksdale. He is a native of Ashdown, Arkansas, and a graduate of LA Tech and LSU. He was a co-pilot on one of seven B-52's launched from Barksdale at the beginning of the first war against Iraq in 1991. The official name of the event was *Operation Senior Surprise* but the participants re-christened it as *Operation Secret Squirrel*. The bombers flew 14,000 miles in 35.4 hours, refueled in the air four times and launched 35 cruise missiles against the Iraqi early warning and communication systems as part of *Operation Desert Storm*. Details of the mission remained a secret for many years. Col. Ward will speak to us on America's Godly Heritage. If you need transportation to Prime Time, let Bro. Paul know by Monday, July 2.
