It is also the home of an amphitheater which presents the musical passion play, *The Promise*. This is an outstanding musical dramatic play on the life and ministry of Jesus Christ. Glen Rose is also the home of the Fossil Rim Wildlife Center, Creation Evidence Museum, and Dinosaur Valley State Park, where it is said that dinosaur and human footprints can be found in the same geological strata. Your cost for all attractions, lodging and meals is \$300.00 per person. A non-refundable deposit of \$100.00 per person is due by September 2.
