LOTTIE MOON

INTERNATIONAL MISSIONS OFFERING
Well over 100 years ago, a single missionary named Lottie Moon, while serving in China,



began writing letters challenging the American church to send and support more workers to go there. After her death on the field, her challenge was heeded in the

formalization of an offering in her name. By 1888, Southern Baptist women had organized and helped collect \$3,315 to send workers needed in China. Our church goal for this offering this year is \$18,000.00. An Ingathering will be conducted in the morning service on December 9. Many people are answering the call to mission service, but giving to supply their needs has declined. Please pray and give generously that the Gospel may be spread throughout the world.
