## Write This Down!

In a store recently, I saw a quote that said: "Mr. Rogers did not adequately prepare me for the people in my neighborhood." If anyone has the right to this quote, it has to be Job! By the time we reach chapter 19, Job and his 3 accusers are in the middle of their arguments. But it seems in chapter 19 that Job's tone and defense change.

In chapter 19, Job stands up to his accusers and states that God has wronged him (v 6). Then in verse 23, it's as if Job is saying, "OK, enough! Write this down! Here's the bottom line!"

So what did Job want written down – what was important enough to be "engraved in rock forever!" (v 24)? Job 19:25 states: "I know that my Redeemer lives, and that in the end He will stand upon the earth." Verse 27 continues: "I myself will see Him with my own eyes ... How my heart yearns within me!" Vernon McGee calls this "one of the great statements in the Bible." Matthew Henry refers to this as "Job's creed or confession of faith."

The Hebrew word for Redeemer in verse 25 refers to one who avenges or ransoms another; it is the technical expression for the avenger of blood. Job is assured that God will avenge his quarrel. God will be surety for him. What a powerful picture of Jesus, our Redeemer! And Job states that he is yearning for Him!

The recent outpouring of the Holy Spirit as seen on many college campuses, renews a fire in our hearts to proclaim as Job did, "I know that my Redeemer lives! I am yearning for Him!"

May we cry out each day to live in a manner that is sold out, poured out, focused on...OUR REDEEMER. He is going to stand. We will see Him. We are yearning for Him!

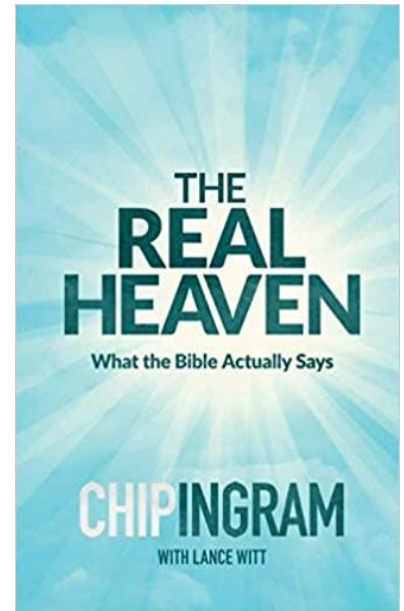
