"When we think about international missions, we envision missionaries crossing oceans and Lottie Moon offerings, but sometimes international opportunities come to Louisiana, supported by Georgia Barnette funds. Pastor David Lee's connection to the Georgia Barnette State Missions Offering goes back 27 years when he came to serve Ban Suk Korean Baptist Church in Bossier City. In those first five years of ministry, Ban Suk Baptist received support from the Georgia Barnette Offering. In 2006, the offering helped fund the construction of their main building where every Sunday you'll find 40 to 50 Korean believers gathering for worship.
