Tucked away in Acts 17:5-10, we see mention of a man named Jason. The name Jason is only mentioned twice in the Bible (also in Romans 16:21). He's not one of the more notable people in the Bible, but he was notable to Paul and Silas.



Jason opened his home to Paul and Silas during their stay in the city of Thessalonica. Because he welcomed them as his guests, he and other fellow believers were severely handled by a mob, dragged before city officials, and accused of treason (vv. 5-7). Jason even paid a "security bond," or basically gave a pay-off to the city officials, in order to be released and make sure Paul and Silas were protected. In the eyes of the mob and city officials, Jason was guilty by association. But in the eyes of the Lord, he was *blessed* by association with Paul and Silas. Jason went the length to protect and encourage Paul and Silas – he encouraged them mentally, emotionally, physically, monetarily, and spiritually.

Later, when Paul wrote his letter to the church at Thessalonica, he wrote how much he loved the believers there:

"We loved you so much that we were delighted to share with you not only the gospel of God but our lives as well, because you had become so dear to us." 1 Thess. 2:8

"For you know that we dealt with each of you as a father deals with his own children, encouraging, comforting and urging you to live lives worthy of God, who calls you into His kingdom and glory." 1 Thess. 2:11-12

Jason encouraged Paul and Silas. Paul & Silas encouraged Jason and the Christian believers at Thessalonica. We are called to encourage one another: "Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing." 1 Thess. 5:11
