Scottish born Alistair Begg, Pastor of Parkside Church in Cleveland, Ohio penned the following devotion for his "Bible Through the Year" series.

What does it mean to be a *gospel church*? Over time, a congregation can grow comfortable and content with empty seats in their services and slowly drift into self-satisfaction. A church will only remain devoted to its mission when its members constantly maintain an **outward** gaze.

Jesus encouraged this mindset after He healed the demon possessed man in Mark 5. When the man asked Jesus if he could stay with Him, Jesus told him no – which seems contrary to His earlier admonition to "Follow Me" in Mark 1:17. But Jesus was telling this man that following involved going; going home to his friends and family and telling them "how much the Lord has done for you." Jesus did not want him to rest content with the knowledge of Christ that he had received. He wanted him to make the good news about Christ known to those around him. If we have truly **come to Him**, then we will truly **go out for Him**.

There are plenty of important elements of church life that should never be ignored, but when we neglect evangelism, pursuing these other things becomes like rearranging furniture in a house that's on fire.

Have you received the mercy that is found in Christ alone? Do you know others who have yet to believe the gospel? Then Christ calls you to go home to your friends and tell them how much the Lord has done for you. He calls your church to be a place that welcomes anyone and everyone who wants to meet the One who has made such a difference in your life and the

life of others in your church. Will you accept His calling? This week, with whom are you going to share the One who has done so much for you?
