Somewhere Between Misery and Manna

For 21 verses, the Israelites are singing and praising God as they march away from Egyptian slavery and the Red Sea. "When Pharaoh's horses, chariots, and charioteers rushed into the sea, the Lord brought the water crashing down on them. But the people of Israel had walked through the middle of the sea on dry ground!"

But something happens between Egyptian Misery and Manna from Heaven.

"Then Moses led Israel from the Red Sea and they went into the Desert of Shur. For three days they traveled in the desert without finding water. When they came to Marah, they could not drink its water because it was bitter. . . So the people grumbled against Moses, saying, "What are we to drink?" Then Moses cried out to the LORD, and the LORD showed him a tree. He threw it into the water, and the water became sweet . . . Then they came to Elim, where there were twelve springs and seventy palm trees, and they camped there near the water." Exodus 15:22-27

Only three days into their victorious journey of obedience, and suddenly they are hit with a tremendous trial of thirst. And lo, the oasis of Marah appears and the problem is solved! Not so fast, my friend. The solution is bitter and won't work. Rejoicing turns to overwhelming discouragement. We've all been there; trying so hard to live out the Christian life in obedience to God's Word, when we're abruptly hit by adversity (illness, financial woes, family disputes, etc.). We reach for a logical solution but it doesn't' calm the chaos. Things are spiraling out of control and panic sets in. We **must** follow the example of Moses and "cry out to God" in our most honest and earnest prayer, giving up our power and control in total submission to Him.

What a beautiful phrase, "the LORD showed him a tree." There is no greater relief than Divine revelation with healing properties. Moses threw it into the water and the water became sweet. We may feel dull, surrounded by average things, but God's power transforms the ordinary into the extraordinary. Can we even imagine the thrill of that cool, calming, life-giving water? Little did they know, Manna from Heaven was waiting for them in the very next chapter! Don't give up, for God has Manna waiting for you too! cp
