WALKING WITH JESUS ~ TRIUMPHAL ENTRY

This week, as we continue our focus on the days leading up to Jesus' crucifixion and resurrection, we join Jesus as He enters Jerusalem, with the crowds cheering and rejoicing! It is known as Jesus' Triumphal Entry.

The distance between Bethphage and the Eastern Gate of Jerusalem is approximately two miles. It was a steep, winding road. What a joyous event to witness...hundreds, possibly thousands, praising Jesus, their Messiah, The Anointed One, that they had been awaiting for generations! They might have been saying, "I didn't think I was ever going to see this!" Or, "Can you believe it! It is actually coming to pass!"

But wait – as Jesus neared Jerusalem, our Savior begins to weep! Luke records: "As He approached Jerusalem and saw the city, He wept over it and said, 'If you, even you, had only known on this day what would bring you peace—but now it is hidden from your eyes.'" (Luke 19:41-42)

In the midst of this beautiful, happy event, Jesus weeps over His beloved City of David. He weeps for the souls that didn't have "eyes that see and ears that hear." (Matt. 13:13-15) In the Greek language, the word for weep used here is *eklausen*; it means to sob, to wail aloud. Jesus openly displayed His deep emotions. Jesus sobbed for them -- that they had not seen and accepted the peace He came to offer them.

This is the same peace that Jesus still offers to all who believe in Him. "Peace I leave with you, My peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid." (John 14:27)

May our prayer on this Palm Sunday be: "Thank you, Blessed Savior, for giving us eyes to see Your Peace, and may our hearts also weep over what You weep over."


