THE JOURNEY

Our staff is continuing our study through Charles Swindoll's book, "Great Days with the Great Lives." This week, we looked at Genesis 22 when God called Abraham to offer his son, Isaac, as a sacrifice. Since we have recently celebrated Easter, these verses are extremely poignant because there is so much symbolism between Abraham preparing to offer his son as a sacrifice and how God ultimately fulfilled the sacrifice through His Only Begotten Son, Jesus.

Swindoll presents the question most of us ask, "Why would a good and loving God make a command like this of such an obedient and faithful follower like Abraham?" Swindoll explains that the Hebrew word used for "tested" is *nasah* (Gen. 22:1). It conveys the idea of proving the quality of something, usually by putting it through a trial of some kind. God wanted to prove the validity, the authenticity, of Abraham's faith. Swindoll states, "God knew the heart of Abraham better than Abraham did." God knows us better than we know ourselves!

God sent Abraham on a three day journey to the place He designated for the sacrifice. Along the way, was Abraham worried? Was Abraham praying and pleading for Isaac's life through the three days? Was Abraham confident God would spare Isaac's life? We cannot know for certain because the Scriptures do not tell us what was going on in Abraham's heart and mind during the journey. But we can be confident that God was with Abraham and Isaac as they made the journey.

God led Abraham to Mount Moriah. This very mountain eventually became the capital of God's chosen people, the city of Jerusalem. It was the place where our Holy Divine Father God would offer up His Holy Perfect Son, Jesus, to become our consummate sacrifice. Swindoll elaborates: "...the place where another Father held His Son loosely, laid Him on an altar, and sacrificed Him for us."

Thank you, Father God, that from the beginning **You knew** that Your Only Begotten Son would be the Atoning Sacrifice -- and **You still loved** the world so much that **You gave** Your Son to be the sacrifice for our sins. Saved to serve, Denise
