PRIME TIME TRIP TO TYLER, TX AZALEA TRAIL, APRIL 4

A highlight of each spring season in East Texas is the 10-mile long Tyler Azalea Trail guiding visitors through neighborhoods of quaint brick streets, historic homes, and residential gardens filled with blooming azaleas, dogwoods and tulips. The first Azaleas were planted in Tyler in 1929 by Maurice Shamburger, in the Lindsey Lane area. Other neighbors soon followed, and the area became well known for its springtime beauty. Over the years the word spread across East Texas and beyond about Tyler azaleas. In 1960, the first marked tour routes were established to help guide tourists. We'll leave EBC at 8:00 (yes, in the am). An experienced step-on guide will help make sure that we see all the good stuff. Lunch will be at the Potpourri House. Your only cost will be for lunch.
