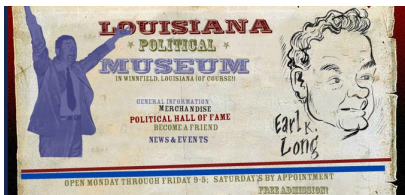
PRIME TIME, JUNE 4
