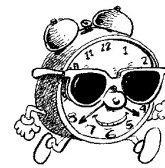
WEAR THE RED, WHITE & BLUE

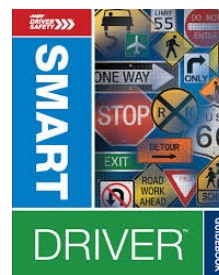
