## Forerunner

March 17, 2022

Today, March 17th is St. Patrick's Day. Patrick was a Christian missionary in Ireland during the fifth century. Legend credits Patrick with teaching the Irish people about the doctrine of the Holy Trinity by using the shamrock clover to illustrate the three persons of our one true God.



Just as Patrick ministered fifteen centuries ago, our Southern Baptist missionaries are ministering to Ukrainian refugees in a war zone this very day, March 17<sup>th</sup>, 2022. God has used International Mission Board workers with significant language skills and cultural understanding to communicate with these desperate and grieving people. Our precious missionaries are meeting these folks at train stations and bus stops, offering physical hugs and spiritual hope through Jesus Christ. It has been reported that when the refugees arrive and are finally warm and fed, they begin to weep for the first time, with relief from having survived the exploding bombs and bullets.

Ukraine Baptist Theological Seminary in Lviv, Ukraine has helped about 8,000 refugees flee since Russia invaded February 24<sup>th</sup>. The school is providing shelter, food, clothing and counseling 24 hours a day to these devastated, now homeless people. The seminary president, Yaroslav Slavik Pyzh is an alumnus of Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth, Texas. When asked if he had a plan to escape, he replied, "No, I have a plan to expand!" Pyzh thanked the United States and Southern Baptist's "Send Relief" in particular for their monetary and prayer support. He begged for us to pray for miracles in Ukraine.

SBC's **Send Relief** is a collaboration between the International Mission Board (Lottie Moon offerings) and North American Mission Board (Annie Armstrong offerings) to spread the gospel through compassionate ministry in crisis areas around the world. Several of our church members have asked for information to give through the Southern Baptist Convention.
