*"Be still, and know that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations,
I will be exalted in the earth! Psalm 46:10*

When we enter the sanctuary on Sunday Morning, do we feel the breathless anticipation of meeting a king; The King? As we hear the beautiful prelude music, do we feel the awed silence of meeting Jesus at His Throne? Or are we preoccupied with seeing who is there and who is not. Do we like those songs in the bulletin? Did we agree with the discussion in Sunday School? How much should we give to the mission offering? What do we want to eat for lunch? How long will the sermon be? What's on the menu for Wednesday Night Supper? How 'bout that hairdo? I mean what was she thinking?

The students of Wheaton College felt the same way on September 22, 1967, until the speaker walked onto the platform. They had assembled for chapel that morning and suddenly realized their beloved Chancellor, Dr. V. Raymond Edman was back in the pulpit. They reached for their Bibles as Dr. Edman rose to speak, expressing his thankfulness for having recovered from a heart attack. *"This will be the first time in more than ten months I have attempted to speak in public. But I want you to consider with me an invitation to visit a king."*

After describing the majesty of meeting the King of Ethiopia, the Chancellor said, *"But I speak primarily of another King. This chapel is the house of the King. Chapel is a time of worship, a time of meeting the King. Come in, sit down and wait in silence before the Lord. Your heart will learn to cultivate what the Scripture says, Be still, and know the I Am God.*

Over these years I have learned the immense value of that deep, inner silence as David, the king, sat in God's presence to hear from Him, the Almighty King." And with those words, Dr. Edman slumped forward as he entered the eternal presence of the King.

"I was glad when they said unto me, let us go into the house of the Lord." Psalm 122:1

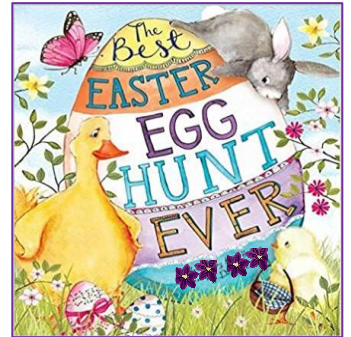
