Hosanna! There it is -- the one word, the one cry, the one exclamation of praise that publicly launched the final week of our Savior's life on Earth before His crucifixion and resurrection. The word hosanna is a Hebrew expression which originally was a cry for the Lord to "save us." (Ps.118:25) In the New Testament, it was translated into a statement of praise, "God saves us!" (Matthew 21:9 & 15; Mark 11:9-10; John 12:13) It is both a plea and an exclamation of praise and confidence.

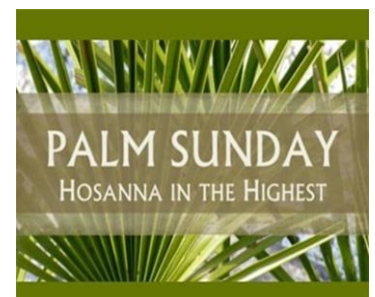
This next Sunday is Palm Sunday. For Christians, Palm Sunday marks the beginning of the week before the crucifixion and resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. It is often called the Passion Week or Holy Week.

The disciples were unaware that this was to be Jesus' last week with them prior to His crucifixion and resurrection (excluding the glorious 40 day reunion following Jesus' resurrection!). But our all-knowing, all-powerful Savior knew the focus of this week. Every detail of this week was important; everything was significant. Every action, every word, every meal, every prayer that Jesus shared during this week displayed an urgency, an importance--it was intentional. Now certainly, Jesus' ENTIRE life on Earth was important and was filled with purpose. But these last days and hours really speak to our hearts, revealing to us our Savior's heart.

Let's spend this week re-reading the chapters in the Gospels that trace Jesus' last week. Let's walk each day down the same paths Jesus walked that final week, His week of passion, His week of inexpressible love. (Matthew 21-27, Mark 11-15, Luke 19-23, John 12-19)

We can begin this week with the same word: **Hosanna!** We can cry to God to help us, to speak to us, to open our eyes to see new things in His Word. And we can also say "**Hosanna**" as an exclamation of praise and thanks to God for saving us, for loving us, for showing us the way!
